Shall the Taylor County Board of Supervisors, having declared Emergency Medical Services essential to the health of citizens in Taylor County and upon recommendation by the Taylor County EMS Advisory Council, for the purpose of creation and maintaining a steady funding stream for all emergency medical services in Taylor County, including, but not limited to, ambulance services, first response services, personnel, equipment, and training, be authorized for a period of 15 years, to levy and impose a tax not exceeding sixty cents per one thousand dollars of assessed valuation on all taxable property within Taylor County, commencing with the levy of property taxes for collection in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2027?
