All the qualified Electors of Taylor County, Iowa are hereby notified that a Special Election will be on Tuesday, January 13, 2026.

**ALL POLLS IN TAYLOR COUNTY OPEN AT 7:00 A.M. AND WILL CLOSE AT 8:00 P.M.**

**THIS SPECIAL ELECTION ONLY APPLIES TO DISTRICT 2 VOTERS. PRECINCT 2 POLLING LOCATION WILL BE IN THE LOWER LEVEL OF THE TAYLOR COUNTY COURTHOUSE AS SHOWN BELOW.**

#### **Polling places:**

**Bedford, Clayton, Gay and Jefferson Townships; and that portion of Benton Township East of a line beginning at the intersection of the centerline of State Highway 148 and the North line of Benton Township, thence South along the highway centerline to the South line of Benton Township. Also, the City of Bedford and the City of Blockton.**

Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered-such as voters registering to vote on Election Day and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence, if required): 1) may have voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the County Auditor's office by January 20, 2026. Election Day Registrant attesters must provide an approved form of identification. Absentee ballots are available in the Taylor County Auditor's Office. Absentee Voting will take place from December 24, 2025, through January 12, 2026. The Auditor's office normal working hours are 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday – Friday. Monday, December 29, 2025, is the last day to request an Absentee ballot by mail, the office will be open until 5 p.m. The office will also stay open until 5 p.m. on January 12, 2026, for Absentee Voting. If you would like to vote but can't make it during the Auditors Office open hours, please call 712.523.2280 so we can accommodate setting up a time for you to vote.
