Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered-such as voters registering to vote on Election Day and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence, if required): 1) may have voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the County Auditor's office by June 8, 2026. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification. Absentee ballots are available in the Taylor County Auditor's Office. Absentee Voting will take place from Wednesday May 13, 2026, through Monday, June 1, 2026. The Auditor's office normal working hours are 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday - Friday. The Auditor's Office will be open Saturday, May 30, 2026, for Absentee Voting from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday, May 18, 2026, is the last day to request an Absentee ballot by mail, the office will be open until 5 p.m. The office will also stay open until 5 p.m. on June 1, 2026, for Absentee Voting. If you would like to vote but can't make it during the Auditor's Office open hours, please call 712.523.2280 so we can accommodate setting up a time for you to vote.
