

**RESOLUTION FOR INCREASED LEVEL OF MAINTENANCE TO AREA SERVICE ROAD**

**Taylor County Resolution No. 2026-18**

WHEREAS, Taylor County desires to classify certain roads on the area service system in the County to provide for an increased level of maintenance; and

WHEREAS, Taylor County, after consultation with the County Engineer, has the authority to reclassify certain roads within the County as Area Service "A" roads pursuant to Iowa Code Section 309.57; and

WHEREAS, the Taylor County Board of Supervisors, after consulting with the Taylor County Engineer, desire to designate various roads in Taylor County from Area Service "C". Roads to Area Service "A" Roads to provide for an increased level of maintenance in order to best utilize maintenance funds, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Notice of Public Hearing duly published according to the Iowa Code, Public Hearing as held on the 22nd day of January, 2026 at 11:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors room at the Taylor County Courthouse, Bedford, Iowa, to hear support and/or objections from the public on roads so designated.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF TAYLOR COUNTY that this County does hereby establish the road described as an Area Service "A" road, with increased access and an increased level of maintenance.

Marshall Township Section 33 & 34, County Road Post Avenue beginning at a point 50 feet north of the intersection of Post Avenue and 220th Street in the southwest quarter of Section 34 Marshall Township (T-69-N, R-33W) thence north 1.040 mile to point of termination.
