RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PAY INCREASES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2027

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-22, A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING SALARIES AND HOURLY INCREASES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2027.

FOR SPECIFIED EMPLOYEES OF TAYLOR COUNTY AN AT- WILL EMPLOYER AS FOLLOWS

WHEREAS, the Taylor County Board of Supervisors has recommended an annual salary of \$75,000 for the Auditor, Treasurer, Recorder and Assessor. The Taylor County Sheriff will receive a 3% raise and County Attorney wage will increase to \$78,400 and County Attorney Secretary wage will increase to \$51,445.94 for Fiscal Year 2027 beginning July 1st, 2026.

WHEREAS, these annual salaries will remain in effect until the Taylor County Board of Supervisors see fit to increase or decrease said salary by Resolution only.

WHEREAS there will be a 3% across the board increase in all other wages and salaries that are not based directly off the salary of said elected officials listed above.

WHEREAS Longevity rates will remain the same as approved in the January 16, 2026, Taylor County Handbook and Policy Manual.

WHEREAS, any Department or Employee that is controlled by a Board other than the TAYLOR COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, shall receive wage increase recommended by said Board. The TAYLOR COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS reserves the right to deny any pay increase if such increase is detrimental to said Department or Taylor County financially.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this resolution supersedes all previous resolutions established for the Auditor, Treasurer, Recorder and Assessor, positions, salaries, benefits, and other terms and conditions of employment shall be adjusted accordingly to said offices.
