Resolution Establishing Taxing Period for EMS Levy

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors (the "Board") of Taylor County, Iowa has previously declared emergency medical service to be an essential county service by Iowa Code 422D.1, Resolution #2025-6 and

WHEREAS, the Board has established a county emergency medical services system advisory council (the "Advisory Council") pursuant to Iowa Code 422D.1(2)(b). The Advisory Council has researched and assessed the service needs of the County, and reported its findings and recommendations to the Board: and

WHEREAS, the Board requested the Taylor County Auditor place a public measure to levy funds for medical services by a tax rate of no more than sixty cents per one thousand dollars of valuation on the next eligible/qualifying election.

WHEREAS, The Auditor placed Public Measure UE-EMS on November 4, 2025, City / School Election. Public Measure UE-EMS Essential Services was approved with a vote of 994-yes to 393-no votes. Levy funds per the election ballot wording will be used "including but not limited to ambulance services, first response services, personnel, equipment and training".

THEREFOR, The EMS Levy will begin with 2025 Valuations, payable FY26/27, The levy will remain in place for 15 years, ending with 2039 Valuations, payable FY40/41. The levy funds will stay in a separate fund under the discretion of the Board. Requests will be made to the Board for approval by claim to Taylor County.
