RESOLUTION NO. 2026-33
A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE PLACE AT WHICH NOTICE OF MEETINGS
OF THE TAYLOR COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS SHALL BE POSTED

WHEREAS, the Iowa Legislature has amended Iowa's Open Meetings statute to require every governmental body to designate annually a prominent and conspicuous place for posting notice of its meetings;

WHEREAS, beginning on July 1, 2026, such notice must always be visible for at least twenty-four hours prior to the meeting for which notice is being given; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR TAYLOR COUNTY, IOWA:


Section 1. At least one full business day prior to the commencement of each meeting of the Taylor County Board of Supervisors from June 25, 2026, through and including January 4, 2027, the Taylor County Auditor shall post a meeting agenda, including the time, date, and place of the meeting, facing outward, on the glass exterior door on the west side handicap entrance of the Taylor County Courthouse.


Section 2. On January 4, 2027, organizational meeting, and at every annual organizational meeting thereafter, the Taylor County Board of Supervisors shall designate the place at which notice of its meetings shall be posted for the following year.
